

## The Autumn Jumble sale

Thank you to all who took part either by bringing jumble, setting it out, selling or buying it. The day was miserable but that seemed to be of great benefit, because the Church was packed and the selling very brisk. Masses of stuff was sold and to good purpose. We made the princely figure of £915 which has gone to the church. They are giving a donation to the Mara Appeal in Tanzania which is providing a safe house for girls who are at risk of female genital mutilation or child marriage, both of which are illegal in Tanzania. The girls are schooled and learn a trade, so a very positive outcome.

The rest of the money will be used for the community space project and general costs of the church itself

There were some pre jumble sales of mainly clothes which are sometimes difficult to sell at a better price. These monies came to £114, of which £64 went to pay for the hire of music equipment at the pop up picnic and £50 went towards the cost of netting for the poppy project. This involves the creation of a waterfall of crocheted poppies [6000] I believe, in memory of the 100 year Anniversary of Armistice Day. The poppies will be draped from the tower of Swaffham Bulbeck Church, the Lode war Memorial and other war memorials in the Anglesey Benefice.
