3	Treasurer's report LJ tabled a summary spreadsheet showing £6,396.04 in (including £2,239.92 opening balance) this year, and £3,454.04 out. Excess of income over expenditure due to bank interest and profit from social events. CP thanked everyone for their involvement in the social events – which have been successful so far.	
4	Proposals to set up current and deposit accounts for the charity Agreed now time to move on and just have accounts in the charity name. Current account likely to be a Lloyds Treasurer's Account (LJ to further investigate). Alternative would be the Co-op. LJ also looked at best deposit accounts, and we can get 1.3% as a charity. Nationwide account matures October, so the £26K in that account to be put into a new charity account. Aldermore's account matures February 2017, and we will look for another account to spread our money safely under FSA guidelines. LJ to sort.	LJ
5	Charity paperwork including proposal to advertise for social events organiser CP believes we should seek a volunteer to join the committee as a fundraiser for specific projects and to manage our social activities. He and CR have produced a job description for LodeStar, but it is quite a lot to expect of a volunteer, so to be thinned down and put in the November

The intention would be to grow the “job” gradually.</p> <p>Other documents have been looked at, and will be reported on at the next meeting.</p> <p>Existing directors become trustees initially (as per constitution), to be replaced by others in the village who are nominated or have put themselves forward. Trustees will stand down as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 2 stand down in 2018 (June) - 2 stand down in 2019 - 1 stands down in 2020, and so on <p>With regard to people applying for money from the charity, CR suggested an evaluation procedure, whereby a list of criteria will be scored from 1 – 5 with a minimum total score required in order to proceed. CR to produce.</p> <p>It was also agreed that all applications must be made with the support of a village organisation, with match-funding being a general requirement. However, we are not yet ready to receive applications for money.
